These activities are well-suited for lamination for long-term use. You can also use this file to help children practice their cutting and gluing skills.

If laminating, cut out the triangles and rectangles on pages 2 and 4, and use velcro (such as 0.59" diameter self-adhesive dots) to secure them to their designated pages. For the "Make a rainbow" page with columns, I recommend first attaching both halves of the velcro to the background page so that you can align them evenly. Then align the rectangles and adhere them to the pre-placed velcro.

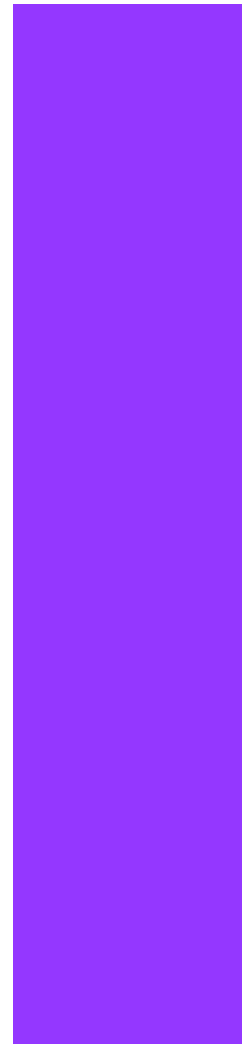
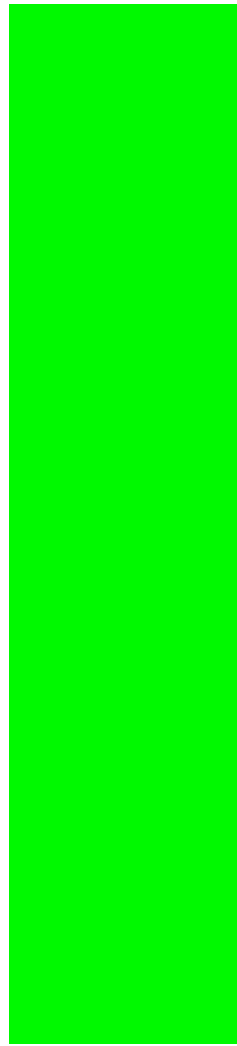
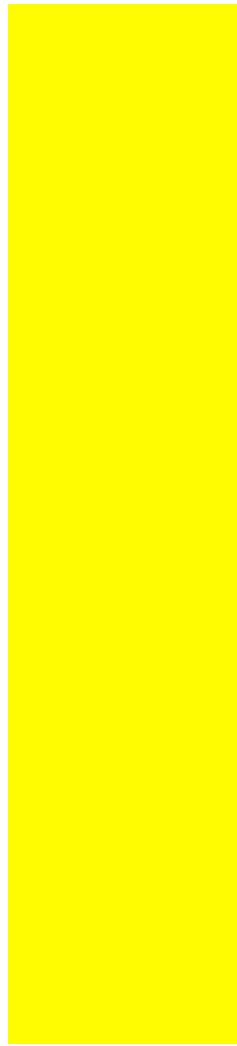
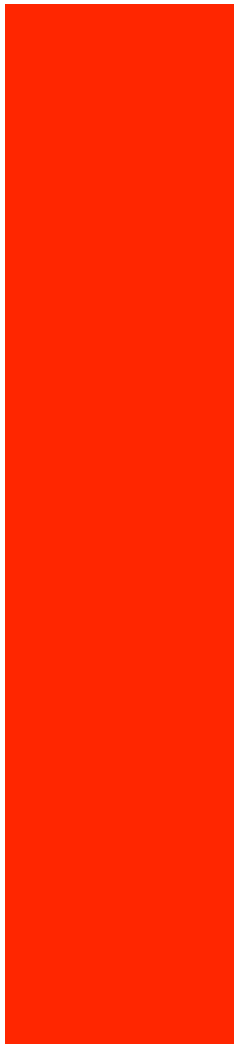
Cut out each triangle.




# Color wheel
