This activity is well-suited for lamination for long-term use.

Cut out the apples and suns, and use velcro (such as 0.59" diameter self-adhesive dots) to secure the numbered items to the tree, sky, and ground. My kids love the apples falling from the tree.

I recommend attaching both halves of the velcro to the background page first so that you can ensure the apples and suns align evenly with the background.

For use, the child can either (a) simply choose a sun or (b) roll some dice, count the dots, and find the corresponding sun. The child then counts out and places that many apples on the background page.

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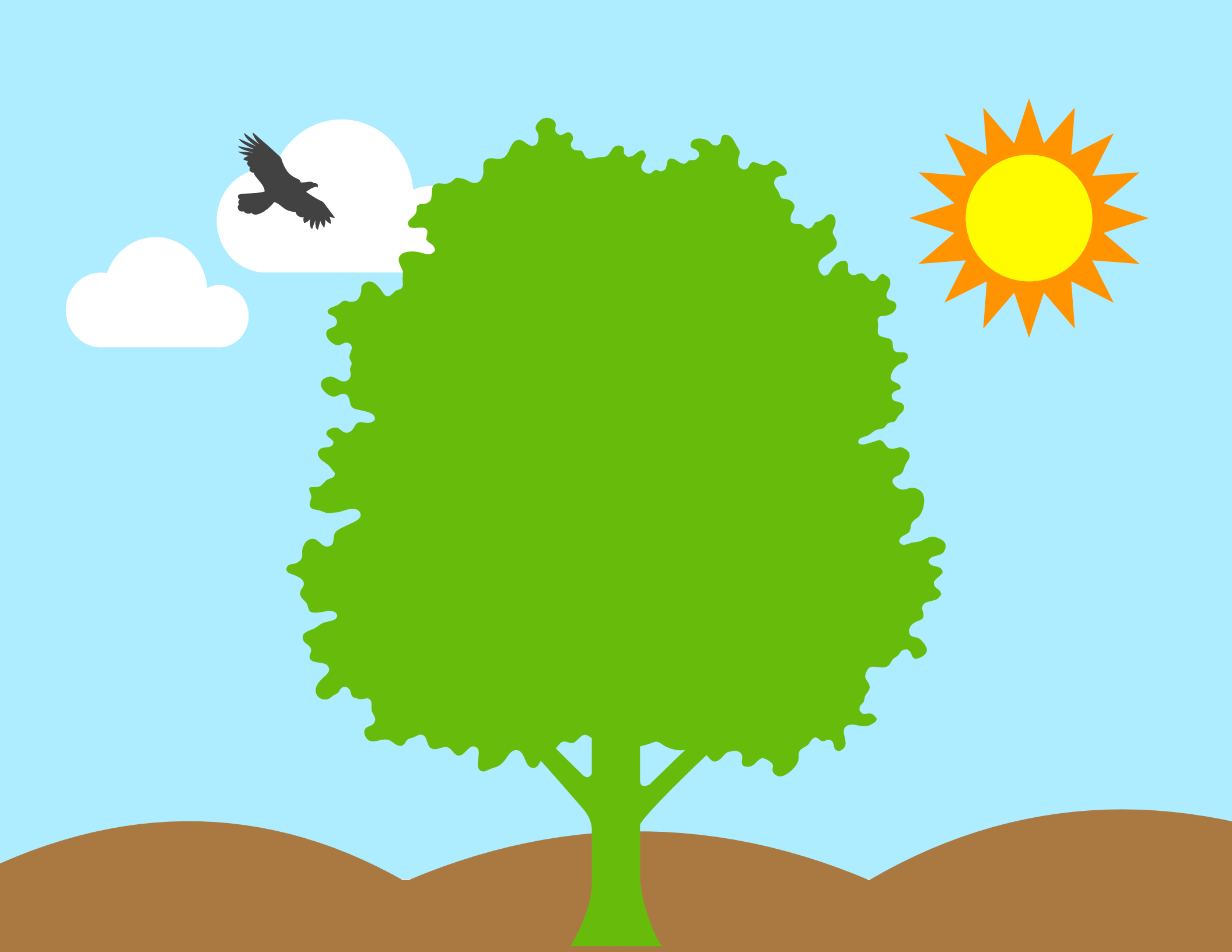
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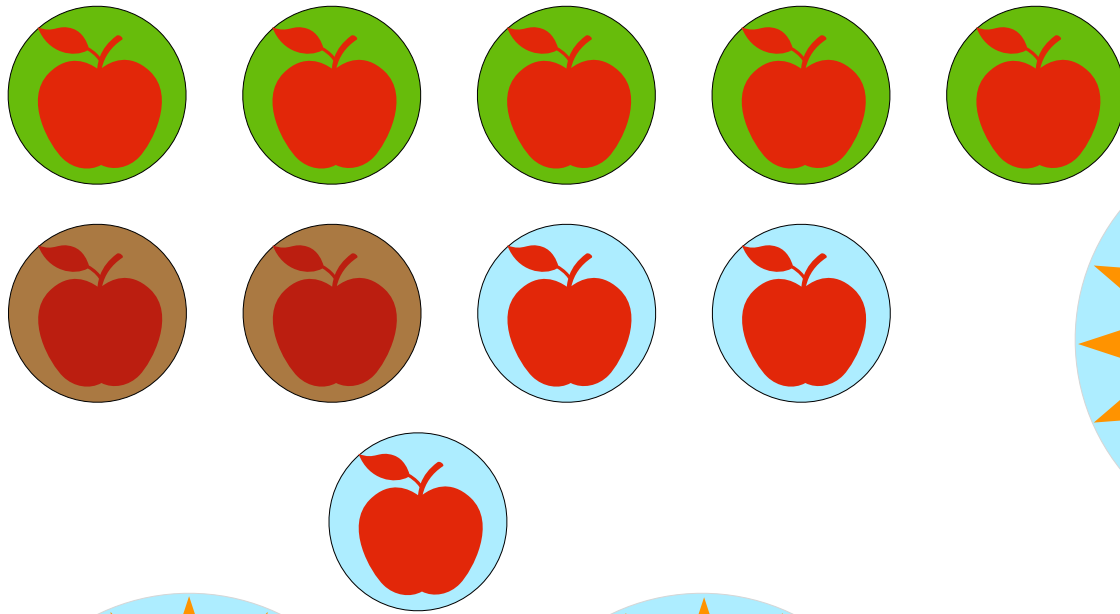
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Cut out these shapes. When a child chooses a sun (or have them roll dice), they then count out and place that many apples.
